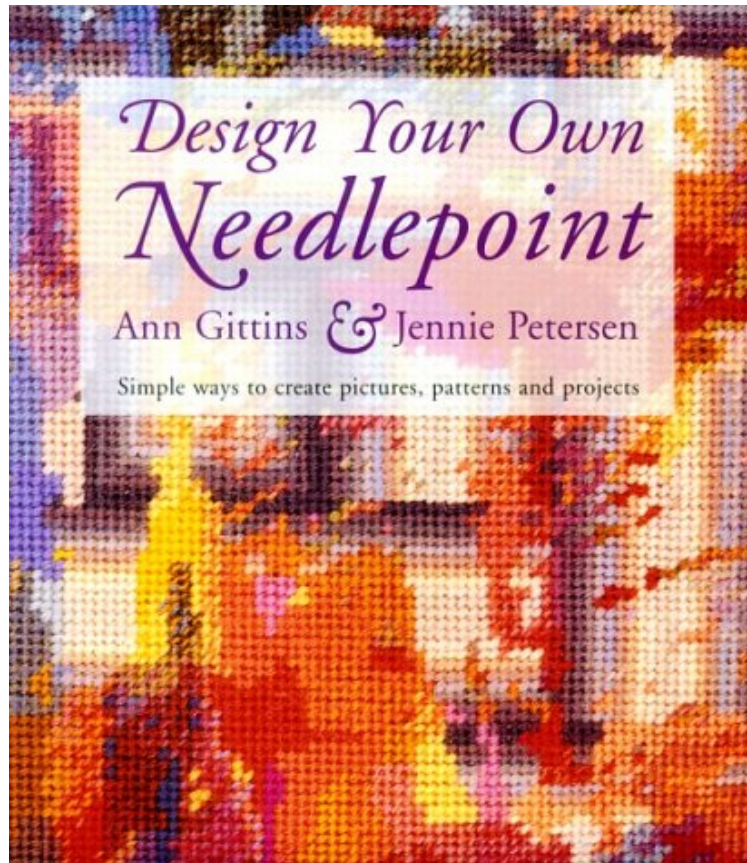

The book includes a guide to basic stitches which will be particularly helpful for beginners, and offers advice on equipment and overcoming problems. Each chapter features a self-contained design project, taking the reader step-by-step from translating the idea on to graph paper, then canvas.
