If you are Drawn to Colour then this collection of images offers a fine art approach to you as a colourist. Rather than a uniform dark line to fill in, each unique still life has been arranged and photographed within the studio and then hand drawn in pencil. Printed in grey, this gives a natural delicacy to the drawings enabling you to create expressive, beautiful and personal artwork. The Constant Artist brings you 16 drawings, traced from original still life

compositions. Each is printed with greyscale guides, hints, tips suggestions on the facing pages. The drawing plates are printed on one side only so you may remove them to frame if desired. The old masters in workshops across Europe would have had numerous studio assistants working to their behest mixing pigments and painting drapes etc. while the artist decided on subject matter and colour.
