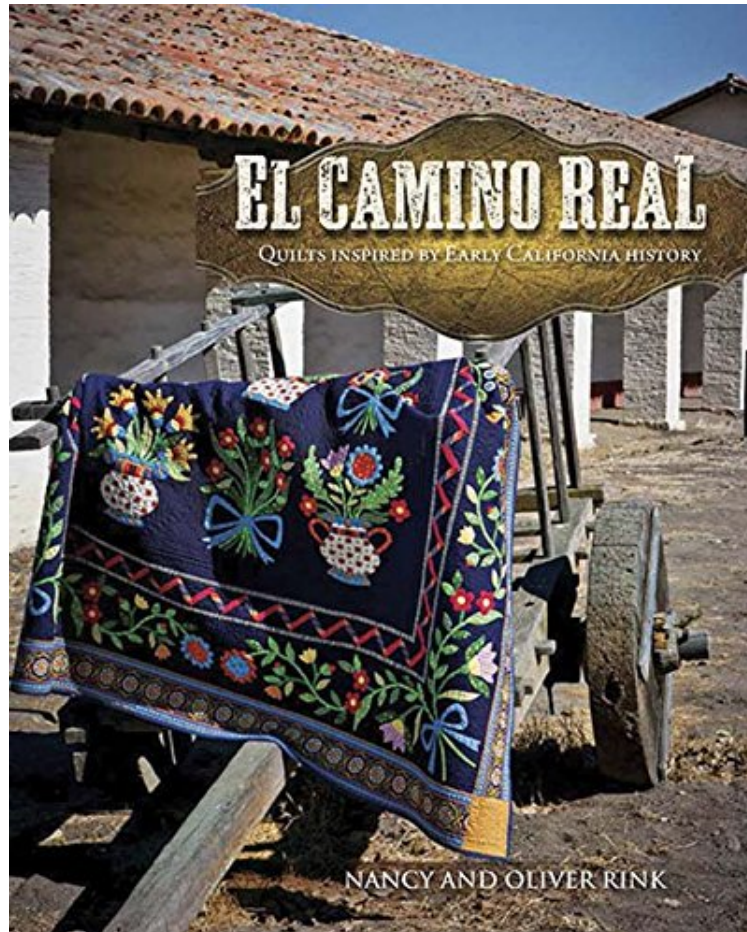

Most recently, Emerald Spring won a first place in Mixed Techniques at Road to California.
