All the pages came out ok in the Kindle edition and navigating was pretty simple but the table of contents doesn't identify the patterns, only the lessons and the index lists the patterns but it wasn't very descriptive. Also, there were pictures of designs (such as those adorable baskets) but the designs aren't in the book. I was hoping to give this book to my niece who is just beginning to crochet, and I still might for the pictures of how to do the stitches but I would want her to use simpler designs so she doesn't get confused. February 10-- I spent some more time going through the book and really checking it out. There are some really nifty e-book features, including links to PDF diagrams and stitch symbols which make the book much easier to use. So I am changing my rating to 4 stars -- I still think a true beginner would need some hands-on assistance to get the best out of this book. And I still have to jump all

It goes through every stitch with clear and thoughtful photos and a project to match each stitch. She gives actual weights for your yarns (instead of just yardage) so you don't have to guess if your yarn will work or if you will have enough. If you read the book she does say what yarns are used for each project...it's just towards the end. I have not found one mistake and all of the projects are wonderful.
