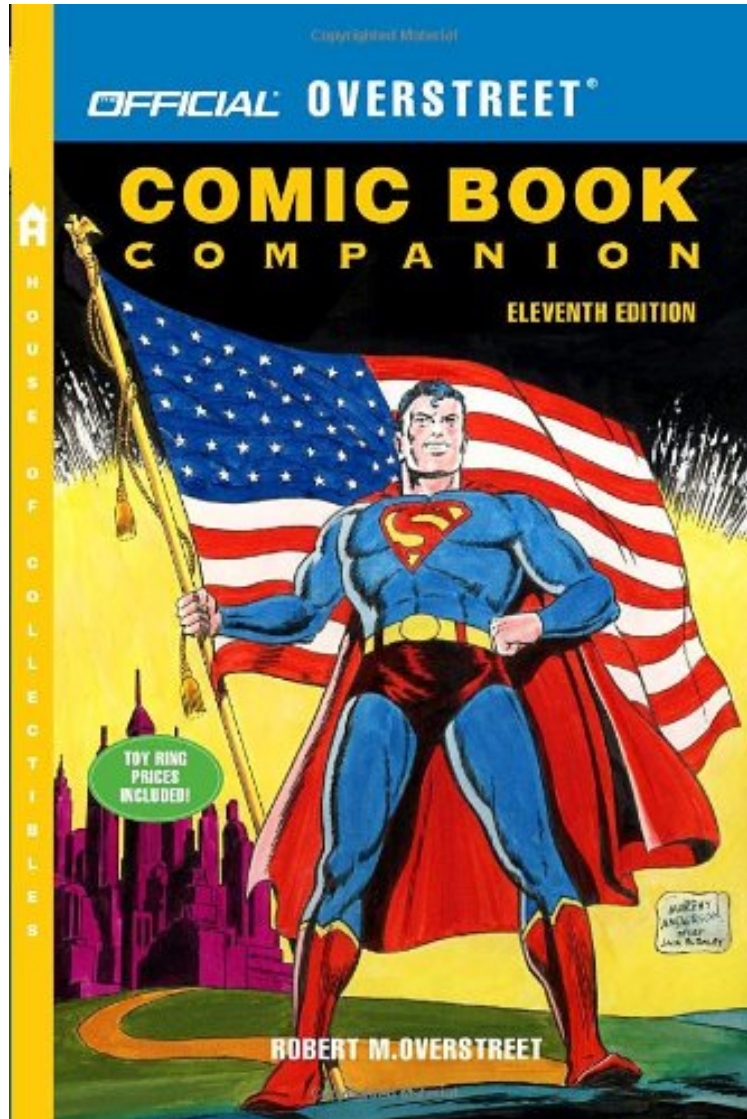

Why does this book exist? By Dennis M. Roy OK, I am not a comic newbie. Been reading them for 45+ years now. Been to a lot of comic shops (and never seen this book for sale in one). Now, I know that this book began its history as THE OFFICIAL HOUSE OF COLLECTIBLES COMIC BOOK PRICE GUIDE. In other words, a competing guide to the nearly-universally acknowledged authoritative The Overstreet Comic Book Price Guide. So obviously at some point Overstreet bought out the competition, but why the need for two separate price guides (even if it is now called the "Overstreet Comic Book COMPANION")?? I WORK in a comic shop (part-time) and don't understand why anyone would buy this rather than the regular Overstreet Price Guide. What does this book provide that the other one doesn't? I admit I have never had one of these in hand (at least, not a recent one) to examine in detail, so maybe I am missing something. Is this guide in any way a "companion" (i.e. an adjunct) to the standard Overstreet guide? I know there is an Overstreet Grading Guide, and I can understand that it provides an additional, in-depth function that the Price Guide does not. If you have the Overstreet Comic Book Price Guide (and if you are interested in the price of collectible comic books, why would you not?), then why would you want or need this book?
