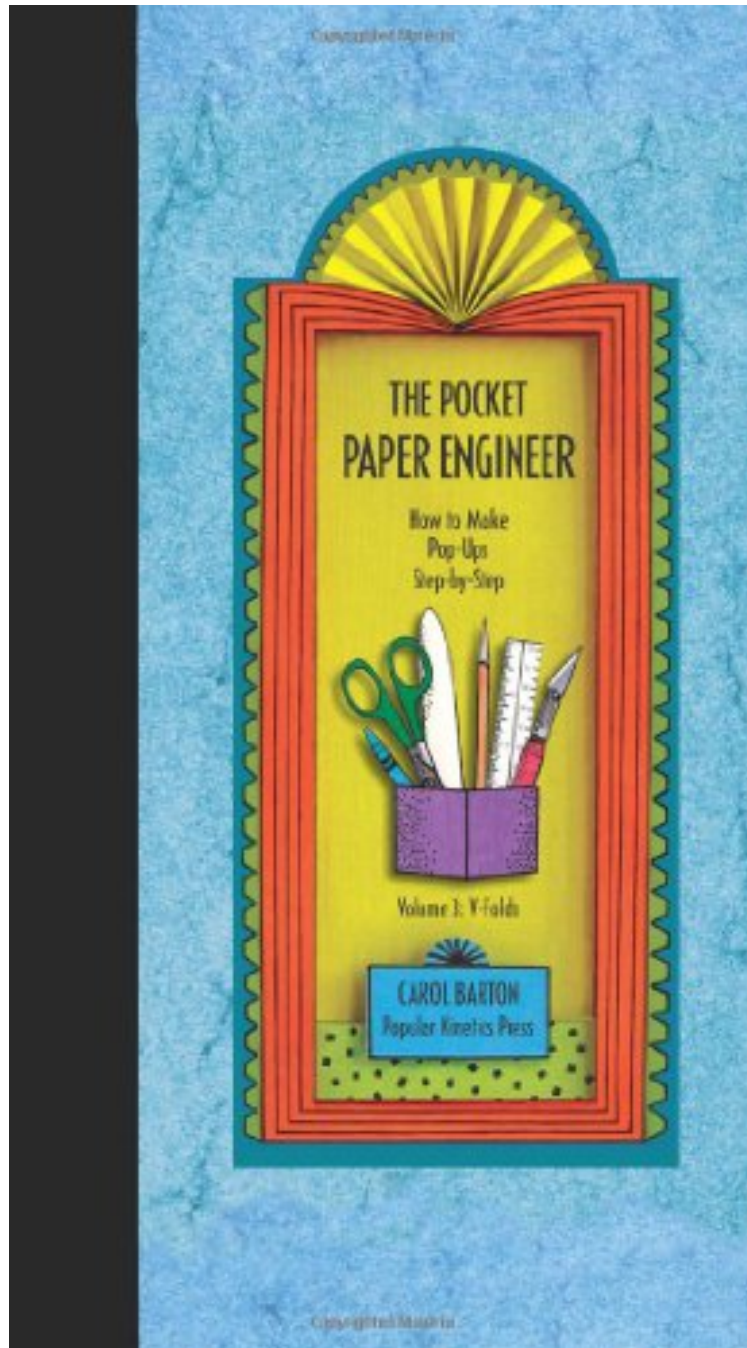

As in previous editions, Ms. Barton sometimes does not explore a subject as very fully as I would have liked--probably never possible in such an undertaking--and so, my appetite just whet, I have gone to different sources and to my own experimentation to try to take certain discreet ideas further. She did this for me, and I also appreciated what was written on it about mistakes being an opportunity.
